Roger Ramirez graduated from George I. Sanchez Charter School in 2004 and attended the University of Texas at Austin. He returned to his public charter high school as a teacher and now works for Rice University in the Office of STEM Engagement.



What I loved most about Sanchez was getting to know teachers from various backgrounds, that one-on-one interaction that I was able to have with the smaller classes. And the campus administrators were very willing to help, to push students to think big.

It was honestly very surreal for me to not only graduate high school, but to be accepted into a university. For many of my peers and family members, college was never an option. Being accepted into a university like UT Austin with a scholarship really, really changed my life.

My charter school opened my eyes to what's really out there, what all students need, and what all people are capable of when given options and support.






